



Hunting the Wild Turkey – Do's and Don'ts, by Harold M. "Skip" Miller, Jr., 5 September 2012

Skip is an accomplished and award-winning amateur photographer of wildlife and landscape subjects. Two (2) of his pictures were selected for inclusion in the Dorchester Heritage Calendar commemorating the 350th anniversary of the founding of the State of Maryland. In 2010 he won First Prize in the Dorchester Center for the Arts amateur photography contest color category.

An avid hunter and outdoors man, Skip was President of the Grand National Waterfowl Association in 2001, served as editor of the Newsletter from 2002 to 2010, and was the Hunt Coordinator from 2003 until 2009. He has been a Director of the Grand National Waterfowl Educational Trust since 2002.

Skip has hunted wild turkeys in Maryland, Alabama, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Florida, Kansas and South Dakota. In 2010, as part of completing his "Grand Slam", he harvested his Osceola in Florida while hunting with George Thornton, CEO of the NWTF, and James Earl Kennamer, Chief Conservation Officer of the NWTF. The event was filmed and later featured on the NWTF's "Turkey Call" TV show. He is definitely one of the obsessed wild turkey hunters.
