Terry Crannell has extensive experience finding, identifying, and displaying Native American Artifacts in this area of the Eastern Shore. He is the Curator of the Dorchester County Historical Society's extensive collection of Native American artifacts, most of which were found in Dorchester County by several local collectors.

Terry's presentation called "Indianbone" was about an accidentally found old Indian burial ground excavated by Bill Yates in the 1960s on Indianbone Road. The artifacts found were studied by the Smithsonian Institute. He talked about the process of handling and repatriation of the material found, and some strange things that have been happening in that area
