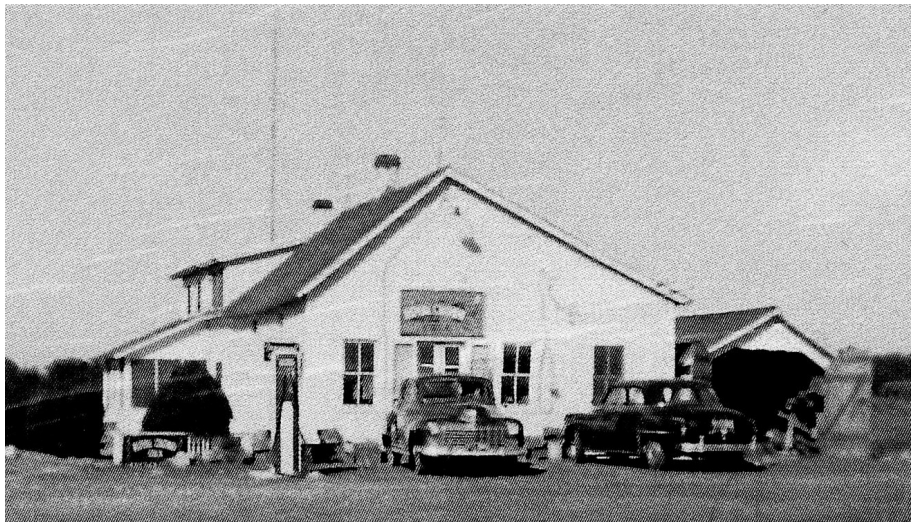




"Businesses in Crocheron and Bishop's Head Years Ago", by Lynne Mills, Wednesday, 1 August 2018
