

A South Dorchester Childhood, by Brice Stump, 7 September 2005

Brice Stump, a journalist, photographer, and author tells the story of his South Dorchester childhood and the disappearing old ghost tales.

Brice Stump grew up on a farm between Bestpitch Ferry and Vienna and developed an early interest in Eastern Shore history and folklore. His professional writing career began at The Banner when he was fifteen. Stump joined the staff of the Salisbury Daily Times in 1979. He is an award-winning Associated Press journalist and photographer as well as the author of three books on Eastern Shore history.
